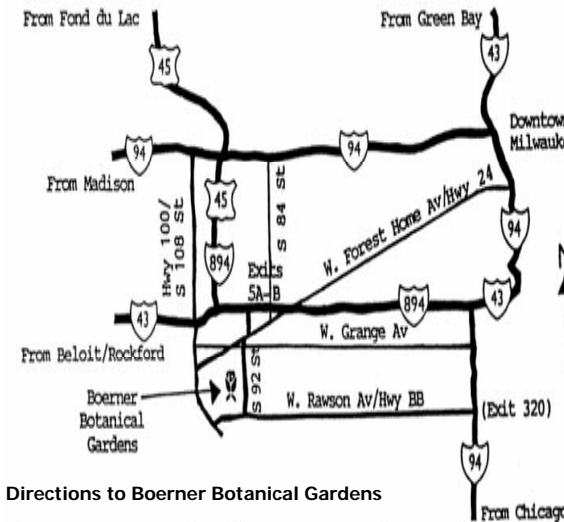

### Directions to Boerner Botanical Gardens

**From the South** (Racine, Kenosha, Chicago)  
Take I-94 to Exit 320 (W. Rawson Ave./Hwy BB)  
Turn left (west) onto W. Rawson Ave. and proceed to S. 92 St. (about 7 miles)  
Turn right onto S. 92 St and follow signs to the Gardens entrance (about 1 mile)

**From the Southwest** (Beloit, Rockford)  
Take I-43 to 894 east, exit 5A-B (76 & 84 St exit)  
Turn right (south) onto 84th St. to W. Forest Home Ave.  
Turn right onto W. Forest Home Ave. and proceed to S. 92 St.  
Turn left (south) onto S 92 St. and follow signs to the Gardens entrance (about 1-1/2 miles)

**From the West** (Waukesha, Madison, Minneapolis)  
Take I-94 to 894/45 south, exit 5A-B south (76th & 84th streets exit)  
Turn right (south) onto 84 St. to W. Forest Home Ave.  
Turn right onto W. Forest Home Ave. and proceed to S. 92nd St  
Turn left (south) onto S. 92 St. and follow signs to the Gardens entrance (about 1-1/2 miles).

**From the Northwest** (Fond du Lac, Green Bay)  
Take Hwy 41 south (becomes Hwy 45 in Milwaukee) to 894 east to Exit 5A-B (76 and 84 streets exit).  
Turn right (south) onto 84 St. to W Forest Home Ave.  
Turn right onto W. Forest Home Ave. and proceed to S 92 St  
Turn left (south) onto S 92 St and follow signs to the Gardens entrance (about 1-1/2 miles).

**From the Northeast & downtown Milwaukee** (Sheboygan, Green Bay)  
Take I-43 to 894 west, exit 5A (W. Forest Home Ave./Hwy24)  
Turn right onto W. Forest Home Ave. and proceed to S 92 St  
Turn left (south) onto S 92 St and follow signs to the Gardens entrance (about 1-1/2 miles).
