## Session Descriptions:

### **Cloverbuds, Session 1, Melissa and Heidi**

They will do a small hand sewing project along with decorating a cloth bag to hold your projects in.

### **Theater, Bob & Sherry**

Come learn the basics of stage presence, blocking, and voice inflection to create character

### **Rocketry, Treva & Dave**

If you are interested in learning how to build a skill level 1 rocket, then this session is for you. During this session you will build a rocket and learn a little bit about what the Kenosha County 4H rocketry project has to offer. Supplies included.

### **Flying Garden, Master Gardeners**

You'll be making a basket out of paper and then planting plants that will connect to paper balloons so you can hang them.

### **Foods, Raina**

**Candy Sushi** – Almost everyone has heard of Sushi, a delicious Japanese food made with vinegared rice combined with various ingredients... but have you ever heard of candy Sushi? We will be creating Sushi-looking desserts with rice cereal and various candies.

**No-bake Dog Treats** – Our doggy family members need treats too! Come learn to make healthy and delicious treats for your pup. Note: peanut butter will be used during some of the preparations, those with peanut allergies should not attend this class.

**Epic Grilled Cheese** – No Wonder Bread and Kraft Singles for this group! We will be combining flavors and textures to create unique and delicious grilled gooey sandwiches.

### **Goats, Vanessa and Valerie**

Come learn about goats how to take care of them and about their industry. This is a great way to also learn about the Kenosha County Goatless goat project.

### **Soap and Lip Balm, Rose**

Join us to learn about the different types of soaps on the market and then make a mold soap along with a simple lip balm.

### **Paracord, Karen and Connor**

Learn how to make a monkey fist key chain and a necklace out of paracord.

### **Poultry, Katelyn**

Are you in the Small Animal Project or want to learn more about poultry? Then this is a session for you. Learn the basics including the care and showing of poultry. The overall Poultry Project. Also get hands on experience in raising chick's and learn about showmanship.

### **Newspaper Collage Art, Megan**

Tear newspaper and magazines and glue together to make a picture.

### **Photography Beginner, Kim**

Learn the basics of photography including different camera settings and concepts like the rule of thirds and leading lines. Youth are welcome to bring their camera to explore basic camera functions. (Two sessions offered).

### **Paintedwood Shapes, Kim**

Painting and decoration of pre-cut wood shapes this could be used as a fair project.

### **Sewing, Session 2 and 3 combined Melissa**

"In this activity, kids will learn to make stuffed owls! Hand sewing large buttons, working with fleece, handling tools, and sewing machine skills will be taught. Excellent for beginner sewers, and anyone interested in joining the project!"

### **Cloverbuds, Session 2 and 3, Danielle, Charlene and Sam,**
